KNOW YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

1. CARRY OVER RX BURNS

Review & make corrections

- Wrong contact names & phone numbers
- Duplicates-triplicates & beyond
- Acres or cubic feet
- Check all your data BEFORE submitting

2. BURN REGISTRATIONS

- SMP I by 10:00 am one business day prior to planned ignition
- SMP II no later than 2 weeks prior to planned ignition
- Keep ID# handy, as well as in burn plan

3. NOTIFICATION

- No later than 10:00 am one business day prior to planned ignition date
- Notify up to 7 consecutive (NOT random) days!!!
- Only burn AREA or VOLUME indicated on notification

4. CANCELLATIONS

PLEASE, When you know you are not going to burn, cancel!



5a. EMISSIONS TRACKING

2 weeks following the end of the RX burn project.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

Applies EVERY year, whether burn acres accomplished or not

Whether the burn will be “rolled over” into the next year or not

Fill out Emission Reduction Techniques utilized

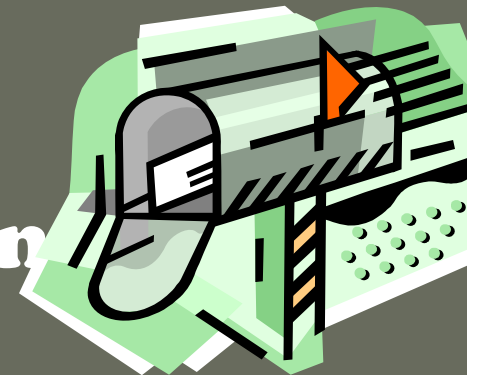


RECOMMENDATIONS
