Thank you for your participation in the San Juan VISTAS program. I would like to give you a brief update on our efforts to develop and expand the VISTAS program. Recently a new partner, Auburn Environmental, joined the program. Auburn Environmental is a leader in the service environmental industry. They are VISTAS Partner #3. They provide the service of using a FLIR Systems ThermoCam® GasFindIR camera and other equipment to locate gas leaks and fugitive emissions.

Our Partners now include: ConocoPhillips San Juan Unit, Red River Compression, and Auburn Environmental.
